Tour Operation:

If we do not have minimum 25 Pax required to operate the group tour, we might operate the tour on other date. We might operate the tour on another date or we can withdraw the tour departure. If the group will reach late due to traffic jam or any other justify reasoning. It's possible that we can cancel the sightseeing/excursion.

In the event of a breakdown of a coach on a touring holiday, our liability will be limited; if, for any reason we cannot provide a replacement coach and that you miss out on a significant attraction we will reimburse the amount which we have paid to the supplier, though we will endeavour to replace the coach at the earliest.
